The Parks and Recreation Commission convened in special session on Wednesday, December 6, 2017, at 6:00 pm, in the Council Chambers, Campbell City Hall, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California.

New Business:

A. Park Improvement Plan

Director Capurso stated that the Commission saw this item at the November 1 meeting and as promised staff incorporated comments from the Commission and held a study session with Council on November 21. The purpose was to review the condition of the park playgrounds, review projects programmed in the 5 year CIP, benchmarks against other cities, various funding sources, and discussion about program approach. Are we approaching our scopes correctly, and should we be proceeding with work or with the potential of installing an all-inclusive playground at one of our parks. So the questions to Council were:

1. Project Approach
 - a. Is the project approach to develop project scopes to renovate existing parks to increase play value, meet safety and accessibility standards without significant expansion the right strategy?

In general the answer was yes, we should do as we have been operating but the Council did give us license to not be limited to play elements. Start thinking about exercise equipment.

2. Project Scope Input
 - a. Should significant expansion of the play areas be considered for Campbell Park and/or JDM-Budd?

In general the Council was not overly positive about expanding the play area at Campbell Park. We did let them know we would be looking at the restroom renovation at Campbell Park.

3. All-Inclusive Play

- a. Should the concept of an All-Inclusive Playground be explored in the City, specifically for JDM-Budd? For Campbell Park the answer was not so much, but JDM Budd side was much more open to do the appropriate research to see if something could logistically fit in there. And to research grant funding of some sort.

We have the design for Campbell Park, but not the construction, in the current CIP. The design is in the current year.

We have some rehabilitation for the JDM Rincon side in the CIP and we also show a full renovation in year 5. If we get into a funding issue in the CIP that is a project that can probably go out a year or two.

We have Virginia Park in year 5 and that will probably stay there.

We did get the greenlight that we should put some time and energy into updating the parkland dedication fee.

Questions:

Q: Looking at the Park fee won't happen until 2019, can we do a temporary increase?

A: We don't have the resources right now and we don't know what it would take to do that study. We are going to propose getting some budget for this in the next fiscal year. A temporary increase would be a question for the attorney.

Q: Do we know what it would take, what the needed resources might be to calculate the rate. Is it a person or an accounting firm? Is there a way to make it happen sooner?

A: It would probably require a real estate appraisal firm with experience in this type of benchmarking. There's a formula that goes with this. We would have to stop doing something else that we are working on in order to do this. We need to do some research to see what it would cost.

Q: Is this an ordinance?

A: No, I don't think so. Our ordinance defines the service level. We have an ordinance, a policy and a fee structure. We do have a budget review with council in February and if something can be pulled together by that time we'll see if we can include something.

Q: Can other cities share their formula?

A: That's a good question. We don't get that great of information from the West Valley Cities except possibly Cupertino. We get the best information from two of the real estate districts that touch us that are part of San Jose. There's the Willow Glen district and the west San Jose district. Unfortunately San Jose doesn't use a consultant, they do it in house. Maybe we could contract with them.

B. Ordinance changes to Jack Fischer Park and City Council comments regarding dogs in parks.

Director Capurso stated that we now allow dogs in Jack Fischer Park on leash on the pathway. The definition of the pathway actually got a lot of discussion. There were no public comments. Council was so happy to do this that they asked staff to look into the feasibility of allowing dogs on and off leash at far more facilities than we do now. This was a non agendized discussion. It was agendized at the end of the meeting. They are interested in allowing dogs on leash at far more facilities.

In Cupertino, Los Gatos and San Jose their default is to allow dogs on leash everywhere except where they distinguish they cannot go. We will be going back to Council probably sometime in early 2018. They also want to talk about an off leash facility. That will probably come before the Commission in early 2018. We will put a generic dog item on the January calendar.

C. 2018 meetings

Director Maurantonio said she and Director Capurso thought it would be a good idea for staff to do presentations to the Commission regarding departmental operations to make the Commission aware of the different divisions in each department and who's in charge in each area, and also to give the supervisors the opportunity to present before the Commission and meet the Commissioners and have more interaction. The first one will be presented by Lauren Merriman, Community Center Supervisor.

Committee Reports:

Parks and Creek Trail: Commissioner Gibson said things are looking good; Fischer Park gets a lot of use. Staff's expertise shows up all the time. The restroom at Campbell Park – does that money have to come from the open space. Director Capurso responded that there is no definitive answer. Some cities are more stringent on their park dedication fees. The Council may say don't spend the parkland money on the restrooms. The problem is there is no readily available alternative. Staff can't bring a proposal to Council on a project that can't be funded. Commissioner Gibson asked if the County could help with that. Director Capurso said he would check on that. There may be some grant opportunities coming up.

Trees: No report.

Special Events: No report.

Staff Reports:

A. General Plan Monthly Update

Director Capurso said there is nothing new to report since the last meeting.

Parks: Director Capurso

- Staff has been researching a goose poop sweeper as well as some chemical treatments that are no to low toxicity that have a bad taste to take care of the problem on the sports fields.
- We are also considering introducing Bermuda grass on the sports fields.

- Gomes Park has been renovated. It has all new landscaping, renovated irrigation system, lower water need plants.
- The Downtown Campbell Neighborhood Association received a grant to install two pillars on Alice Avenue recognizing the historic street.
- Measure Q tree planting, did a volunteer project on Nov. 18 on Nido Drive.
- Council approved the plans, specifications and Engineer's estimate for the Community Center play area and exercise station.
- The tree at the Community Center and the one here at City Hall have been decorated for the holidays. There are additional decorations on the Orchard City Green.
- Staff is working with San Jose on a joint volunteer effort at Hamman Park for Martin Luther King Jr. service day.

Commissioner Fidrych asked if staff will address the drainage issue at the Community Center. Director Capurso said yes it will be addressed.

Recreation and Community Services: Director Maurantonio

- Director Maurantonio is pleased to announce the selection of Kimi Tran as the Adult Center's Recreation Specialist effective November 20, 2017. Kimi's role at the Adult Center will include coordinating trips, overseeing groups and clubs, and supervising the front office staff. Through a competitive interview process Kimi demonstrated her commitment and passion for serving seniors.

Kimi holds a Bachelor's of Arts degree in Social Work from San Jose State University. Since 2015, Kimi has worked as the Adult Center's Nutrition Site Manager where she made a huge impact in connecting with the senior participants. Congratulations to Kimi on a well-deserved promotion!

- Laura Smith, Office Specialist in charge of Community Center Reservations, announced her upcoming retirement in early May. Laura has been with the Department for nearly 20 years and she is amazing at providing excellent customer service to the rental clients. Laura's kindness is legendary and she will be greatly missed. A recruitment will take place in early 2018 so that we can have someone hired in April to cross train with Laura before she leaves.
- On Friday, November 17th, the Campbell Youth Commission hosted a University of California College Workshop. College and Career Center specialists from Westmont, Branham and Prospect High Schools presented tips and tools to assist students with the college admissions process. During the workshop, students were able to spend one-on-one time with specialists and teachers to critique the essay portion of their UC application. Twenty-eight students were in attendance from schools including Westmont, Branham, Leigh, Prospect and Leland.
- Many thanks to Tina Wong-Erling, Senior Services Supervisor, for presenting valuable information at the November 29th Lunch and Learn. Tina explained that many of us are already in a caregiving role if we are helping an elderly family member or neighbor with grocery shopping, driving to appointments or paying bills. We learned about Caregiver resources and the importance of asking for help. Tina did a fantastic job and shared her personal experience as a caregiver.

- December 13th Lunch and Learn – Holiday Baking; recipes from Alex Mordwinow, Salina Flores and me. If you'd like to attend just let her know.
- The Campbell Museum Foundation's annual Holiday fundraiser: Ainsley House Holiday Teas and Tours have just a few days to go! Teas will take place December: 7, 8, 9, and 10. The tea menu includes finger sandwiches, champagne, a special Ainsley blend tea, and tasty treats in the Carriage House followed by a docent led tour of the Ainsley House. This year's Holiday Open House will take place on Thursday, December 14 and Sunday, December 17. Thank you to Sherrie and Joy for continuing their tradition of decorating a room in the Ainsley House.
- City Council will announce their selections for the PRC vacancies on Tuesday, December 19th.

Commissioner Walker said that the staff that put up the holiday decorations always seems to have the best time. They are always so fantastic.


