2. Youth Commission work plan and subcommittee development
 - a. College and Beyond: Will be creating a central place online to share local job opportunities in place of the job fair this year. Would like to have this set up by the end of February.
 - b. Academics: Will be hosting a Presidents' Day themed trivia night on Feb 15 from 3:00-3:30 pm. This is focused on elementary aged students in 4th-6th grade but all are welcome. Additionally planning to host an event in honor of reach across the world day on March 2nd.
 - c. Civic Engagement: Coffee and Politics is planned for April 21st at 5:00 pm. Local politicians are being reached out to see interest in participation.
 - d. Environment: Environmental-themed trivia night being planned for Jan 26 at 7:30 pm. Target audience will be 3rd-5th graders. Will be making the flyer and begin advertising this week.

- e. Wellness: Looking into a letters for seniors event. Waiting to hear from local senior care facilities to see who would like to receive letters.
 - f. Recreation: Planning for a February craft box on the 13th. Holding a cake decorating contest February 15-20th. Commissioners will go live on the 20th to decorate cakes and announce the winner. Would like to hold a chalk art contest in March as well and possibly a drive in movie in April or May if guidelines allow it.
 - g. Social Justice: Planning to hold a zoom event to honor black history month on February 26th. People will bring poetry, art, journals or anything created by black artists or scholars. Additionally hoping to hold an event for women's history month in March.
4. Kindness week Feb 17-19th
- a. Campbell, Saratoga, and Cupertino have discussed ideas for kindness week including a food drive and writing thank you cards for people. Commissioners shared ideas that included: having separate location for canned food drop off, having elementary schools write thank you cards, and thanking local businesses.
