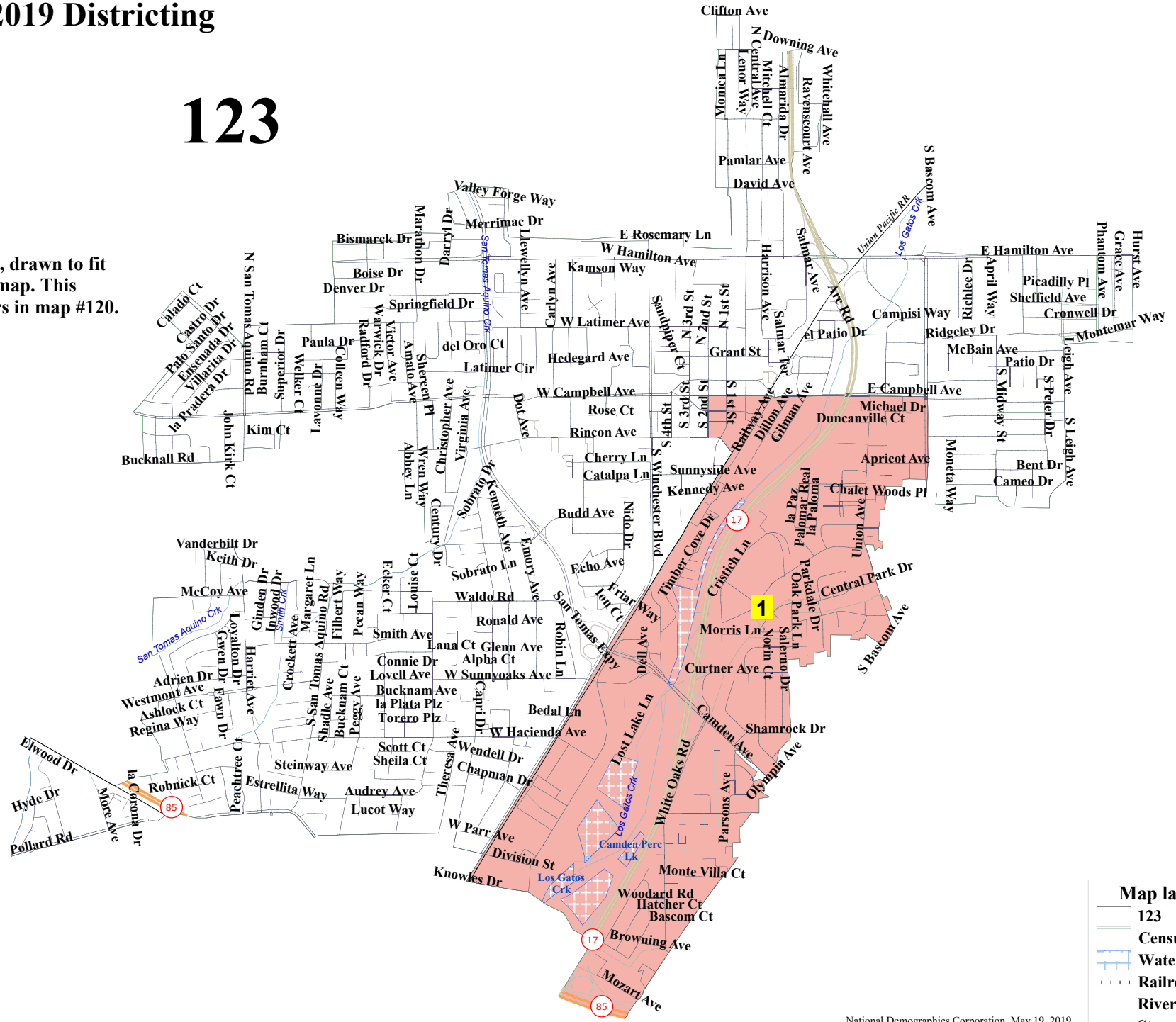


Campbell 2019 Districting
