ADVANCE NOTIFICATION FOR THE UPCOMING HARRIET TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT (18-NN) PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- WHO:** Wattis Construction Co., Inc, of San Jose, California
- WHAT:** Wattis was hired by the City of Campbell to install traffic calming devices on Harriet Avenue. The project's scope of work includes, but is not limited to the following: the demolition and removal of the existing pedestrian flashing beacon system at the intersection of Harriet/McCoy; the procurement and installation of a new pedestrian hybrid beacon system at said intersection; the installation of new ADA compliant curb ramps, spot islands, and speed humps; the application of a slurry seal treatment on Harriet Avenue; and the removal and replacement of existing striping.
- WHY:** The purpose of this project is to provide improvements to slow down traffic and enhance bicycle and pedestrian safety on Harriet Avenue.
- WHERE:** The project will occur on Harriet Avenue between Keith Drive and Westmont Avenue in the City of Campbell, California.
- WHEN:** Working hours are Monday thru Friday between the hours of 8:30AM and 4:30PM. Construction will start the week of August 26th. It is estimated that the project will be substantially completed by February 2020.
- WHAT TO EXPECT:**
- Typical construction noise and minor traffic delays are to be expected during construction hours.
 - On street parking will be restricted at times. Properties directly affected by any construction work will be re-notified 72-hours by Wattis prior to work commencing. On-street parking restrictions will also be posted 72-hours prior to work commencing. Please note that the posted parking restrictions will be strictly enforced. Any vehicles parked within the construction zone will be towed away by the Campbell Police Department at the owner's expense.
 - Work will generally be completed in the following order:
 1. Improvements at the intersection of Harriet Avenue & San Tomas Aquino Road and Harriet Avenue & McCoy Avenue
 2. Speed hump installation on Harriet Avenue
 3. Various tree planting
 4. Slurry seal application on Harriet Avenue
 5. New striping on Harriet Avenue
 6. Installation of the new pedestrian hybrid beacon system at Harriet/McCoy.
