IMPORTANT 72-HOUR NOTICE FOR SLURRY SEALING WORK

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

(Harriet Avenue Traffic Calming Project 18-NN)

WHO: Wattis Construction Co., Inc. (under contract with the City of Campbell)

WHAT: Harriet Avenue is scheduled to receive a slurry seal.

WHY: The slurry seal is a preventive maintenance treatment used to prolong the life of the street.

WHERE: Work will occur on Harriet Avenue near the intersection of Keith Drive to Westmont Avenue.

WHEN: Work will start on Thursday, September 26th, 2019. It is estimated that this portion of the project will be completed by Friday, September 27th, 2019. Working hours are Monday thru Friday between 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Typical construction noise.
- Lane Closures. Lanes will be closed to all traffic while the slurry seal is being applied to the street and while it cures. This process can last anywhere from 4 to 5 hours (cure time is mainly weather dependent). Be mindful of the lane closures and plan your time accordingly.
- Posted traffic control signs. For your safety and for the safety of the workers in the field, please obey all posted traffic control signs and construction workers.
- On street parking will be restricted during this construction operation. Posted restrictions will be enforced. Any vehicles parked within the construction zone will be towed away by the Campbell Police Department at the owner's expense.

ADVISORIES:

- Do put your garbage out on garbage day. Wattis has made arrangements with West Valley Collection and Recycling to do early morning pick-ups.
- Do not wash your cars or water your lawns the day before or the day work is scheduled.
- Do not drive, walk, bike, play, skate, or allow pets on the newly sealed street until it has had time to cure.
- Do not perform any $\frac{3}{4}$ - turns or make any sudden/hard stops with your vehicle for several days after the application of the material.
- Do drive slowly on the newly resurfaced street for several days.
