



ON-STREET PARKING REMOVAL



S. BASCOM AVENUE BIKEWAY PROJECT – Roadway Improvements & Bike Lane Installation

WHAT: Removal of on-street parking at several locations along S. Bascom Avenue to facilitate installation of new bike lanes. For specific locations, please see map below.

WHERE: The City of San Jose will resurface the street on S. Bascom Avenue from Camden Avenue to Samaritan Drive with a Microsurfacing seal in the fall of 2019 and is partnering with the City of Campbell for portions of S. Bascom Avenue that lie within Campbell city limits.

WHY: This preventive maintenance project will help preserve and protect the underlying pavement structure to prevent pavement deterioration caused by ultraviolet light and water penetration; it will also provide a new driving surface.

The project scope will implement new buffered bike lanes with some green bike lane elements at intersections, and will install new ADA compliant accessibility curb ramps as part of the phased components noted in the Valley Transportation Authority’s (VTA) Bascom Corridor Complete Streets Study to improve bicycle and pedestrian travel along the corridor.

WHEN: On-street parking (as shown on the map below) will be eliminated effective October 16th – the first scheduled date of the Microsurfacing of S. Bascom Avenue.
