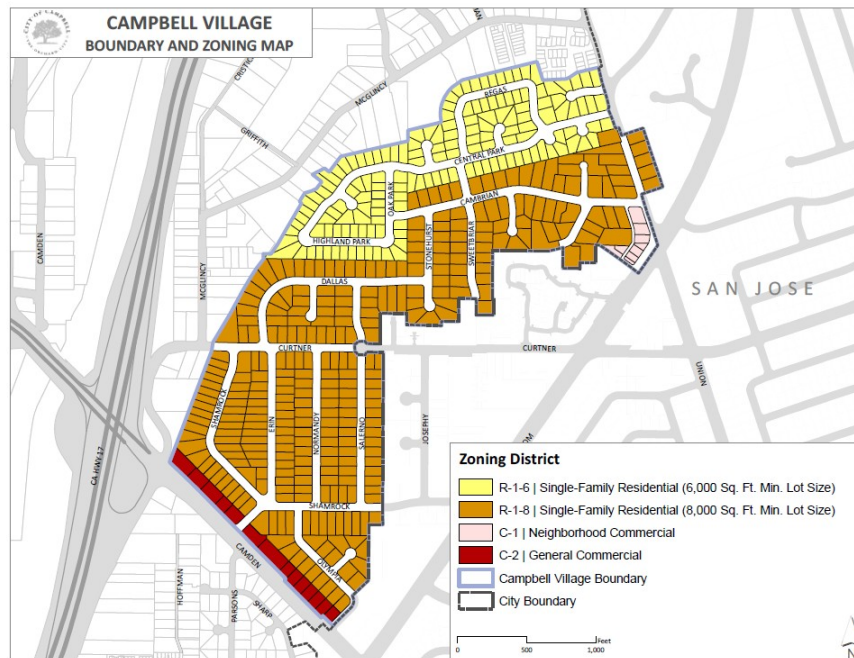




Open House Meeting

Help create the long-term vision of your neighborhood by participating in the preparation of the Campbell Village Neighborhood Plan (CVNP)!

In response to feedback from the City Council at its December 6th, 2016 Study Session, City staff will be conducting a final community meeting before proceeding to the Planning Commission for formal public review.

City staff will be available to answer questions and take additional input on pedestrian access, bike routes, traffic improvements on public property, and seek to resolve any remaining standards for private property improvements.

This open house will be conducted on a drop-in basis. You do not need to attend for the entire time. Stop by anytime between 7:00 and 9:00 pm and ask a question or provide your input.

The Campbell Village Neighborhood Plan is a collaborative effort between the City of Campbell and the community to establish land use policies, transportation policies, and development standards to further the residents' vision of the neighborhood. Discussion during these meetings will address the plan's policies on zoning and the approval process. Please join us to provide your input on these topics.
